Our strength lies in our volunteer network of community-based humanitarian workers, medics, first-aiders, first responders, lifeguards, rescue workers, activists, advocates, lobbyists, and educators who offer their skills in service 'For all humanity'. We actively persuade decision makers to act at all times in the interests of vulnerable or at risk people and communities. We were created to enable all interested humanitarian workers, to offer their skills, in particularly, as first-aider's and first responders covering high risk events and lifeguard cover, to enable medical and healthcare professionals to offer their skills as humanitarian medics for the promotion of humanitarian community public health, to improve humanitarian standards, to poverty regions, disaster stricken or disaster vulnerable regions, to enable all interested humanitarian rescue workers to offer their skills in those disaster stricken regions, and to provide education programs in disaster awareness, preparation & prevention, survival skills, emergency planning in disaster vulnerable regions. The Diplomatic Corps of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent (DCBC) is a non-governmental humanitarian agency that is part of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement, that provides outreach support coordinating humanitarian diplomacy activities and initiatives and establishing relationships with other countries. 'Refusing to ignore countries in crisis', we actively persuade decision makers to act at all times in the interests of vulnerable communities of countries less fortunate. Through activism, advocacy, negotiation, communication, formal agreements, and other measures, we

mobilise the public, governmental support and resources, and facilitate effective partnerships with international and national organisations so we can respond to help vulnerable or at risk people of those countries in crisis.

The Diplomatic Corps's fundamental objective as mandated by the Movement is to work with its bilateral partner the Federation and its national societies to integrate the Diplomatic Corps model into an FBC National Society structure as a foreign affairs office that will coordinate humanitarian diplomacy activities and initiatives, and will establish relationships with other FBC National Society delegations, organising diaspora chapters, and implementing out-reach projects assisting those national society delegations in other countries.

The Diplomatic Corps works in cooperation with the Committee (CBC) to organise and implement the CBC's mission themed Envoy program 'Help4Homeland'. Likewise, it works with other bilateral partner component agencies that form the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement.

The Diplomatic Corps work respects the Movement's fundamental principles, notably those of humanitarianism, volunteerism, moralism, transparency, impartiality, empowerment, sustainability, neutrality, benevolence and respect.

The Command of the Blue Cross & Blue Crescent (CBCCorps) is a non-governmental humanitarian agency that is part of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement, and is the uniformed component that comprises the CBCC - Blue Cross Corps, CBCC - Blue Crescent Corps and the CBCC - Blue Crystal Corps. We act to ensure that our uniformed members in disaster vulnerable communities are resilient and have sufficient competence including practical life-saving skills and organisational expertise, which help them prepare for, respond to and recover from natural and man-made disasters and other emergency crisis.

Command personnel are involved in carrying out a wide range of humanitarian activities within its CBC-Corps Divisional Commands at District level within an FBC National Society, and in cooperation with other bilateral partner component agencies that form the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement.

The Command is mandated by the Movement to develop and coordinate initiatives such as First Responder Corps, Lifeguard Corps, Lifeboat Corps, Medical Corps, SAR Emergency Responder Corps, Crowd Control Corps, Street Chaplain Corps, and Frontline Activists Corps.

The Command's work respects the Movement's fundamental principles, as defined by the Conference of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Movement, notably those of humanitarianism, volunteerism, moralism, transparency, impartiality, empowerment, sustainability, neutrality, benevolence and respect.

The Cooperation's work respects the Movement's fundamental principles, as defined by the Commission, and endorsed by the Conference, notably those of humanitarianism, volunteerism, moralism, transparency, impartiality, empowerment, sustainability, neutrality, benevolence and respect.

The University of Blue Cross and Blue Crescent (UBC), is a non-governmental humanitarian agency that is part of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement and is the international movements mandated 'University for Humanity' established as a treaty organization of the Conference of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Movement (CBCM).

As determined in the Charter of the University, and as mandated by the Movement, the mission of the University for Humanity is: "to provide humanity with an university of humanitarian education with the aim of facilitating and promoting among humanity the spirit of sharing knowledge, skills and understanding among people and to stimulate the use of skills and knowledge to be used to help one another, and to help lessen the effects of disasters and catastrophes on vulnerable populations, in keeping with the noble aspirations proclaimed in the governing constitution of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent".

The vision of the University is to become a network of collaborating 'University for Humanity' centres and activities in different regions, guided by the movement and in cooperation with a large number of universities, NGOs and other partners on education and research.

The University (UBC) organise and implement the 'Streetwise Program' including 'Street Seminars', 'Street Schools' and 'Street Skills' initiatives...to help educate the poor!

The University's work respects the Movement's fundamental principles, as defined by the Conference of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Movement, notably those of humanitarianism, volunteerism, moralism, transparency, impartiality, empowerment, sustainability, neutrality, benevolence and respect.

The University endorses the principles of the United Nations Academic Impact (UNAI) initiative, to generate a global movement of minds to promote a new culture of intellectual social responsibility. The UBC is totally committed to use education as an engine for addressing global problems. We actively support and demonstrate our commitment to the United Nations Academic Impact's ten universally accepted principles.

COALITION



The Coalition of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent (CoalBC) otherwise known as the Coalition, is a non-governmental humanitarian agency that is part of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement, and is mandated by the Movement to work to help form temporary alliances for combined action of organisations who act together to tackle a specific cause or common concern.

Any type of organisation can join our Coalition campaigns and engage in collective actions, organise protests, marches, rallies, campaign stalls and other activities that positively raise awareness on issues of concern. Coalition participants are encouraged to develop local-level alliances as a way to expand activities, build relationships with local businesses and like-minded organisations or government bodies to facilitate support, extend public awareness and increase public participation.

The Coalition's work respects the Movement's fundamental principles, as defined by the Conference of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Movement, notably those of humanitarianism, volunteerism, moralism, transparency, impartiality, empowerment, sustainability, neutrality, benevolence and respect.

The Commission of Blue Cross and Blue Crescent (CmsnBC) or the Commission, is a non-governmental autonomous humanitarian agency that is part of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement, and is a standing commission advisory and regulatory body that establishes Standing Commission Working Groups to provide movement-wide strategic guidance in the interest of all component agencies of the movement. It prepares Movement-wide policies such as the Strategy for the Movement, which aim at harmonious coordination and cohesion in action, building on the strengths and specific mandates of each component. As well as its statutory role it operates as a "Think Tank" on Movement-wide issues.

### COMMISSION OF THE BLUE CROSS & BLUE CRESCENT

Blue Cross & Blue Crescent movement 

The Commission is mandated by the Movement to set standards in best practice, good governance, accountability and transparency within the FBC National Blue Cross or Blue Crescent Societies and consequently public confidence and trust in the FBC national societies work. The Commission works to facilitate audit and compliance of FBC national society delegations, and or FBCO / GCoOp National Cooperative Member NGOs operating in a particular country, assisting them to become compliant, and ensuring they maintain compliance, with the applicable laws, regulations, guidelines, or other government requirements. The Commission is responsible for developing operating guidelines and providing guidance on a countries regulation.

Guidance is advisory only and is intended to be an overview of the key operating parameters, therefore, it is essential that information be confirmed accurate at national level and that both FBC National Society delegations, and or FBCO / GCoOp National Cooperative Member NGOs make their own inquiries as to the status of the law and seek professional legal advice when needed.

The Commission works in partnership with a number of organisations. Most, but not all, of these organisations are national or international charitable IGOs, NGOs, CSOs themselves. These organisations may be in cooperative membership of the Global Cooperative of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent (GCoOp), and institutional members of the Federation of Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Organizations (FBCO). The Commission also works with other bilateral partners, the Federation of Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Societies (FBC), and other component agencies that form the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement.

The Commission has defined the Movement's fundamental principles, approved by the Conference of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Movement, which are to be shared by all components of the Movement, notably those of humanitarianism, volunteerism, moralism, transparency, impartiality, empowerment, sustainability, neutrality, benevolence and respect.

### Global Cooperative of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent

Blue Cross & Blue Crescent movement 

The Global Cooperative of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent (GCoOp) is a non-governmental humanitarian cooperative agency, that is part of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement, that forms unique cooperative alliances and brings together our member organisations or our ordinary members, to participate in, and benefit from, various thematic cooperative platforms. In keeping with the 'Cooperative Principles', membership of the Global Cooperative's thematic platforms are open to either all 'member organisations', or all 'ordinary members'. Although, participation in thematic organisation

cooperative's requires that each member organisation has the capacity to participate equally with other member organisations, likewise participation in thematic cooperative's open to all ordinary members (humanitarian worker cooperatives) requires that each individual has the ability to commit and undertake a fair share.

As determined in the Charter of the Global Cooperative, and as mandated by the International Movement, the fundamental objective of the Global Cooperative is to work to help develop, implement and support a number of thematic cooperative platforms operated by either our member organisations for the benefit of our member organisations, or operated by our ordinary members for the benefit of our ordinary members, using the services of that thematic cooperative platform.

The Global Cooperative works in collaboration with our bilateral partner, the Federation of Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Organizations (FBCO), to guide and support the development of its National Cooperative's, and to provide capacity building support, and it does this in cooperation with other bilateral partner component agencies, that form the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement, to develop 'humanitarian worker cooperatives'.

The Global Cooperative's work respects the Cooperative Principles of (1) Open, Voluntary Membership, (2) Democratic Governance, (3) Member Economic Participation (4) Autonomy & Independence, (5) Education of members and public, (6) Cooperation between Cooperatives, (7) Concern for the Community. Additionally, GCoOp's work respects the Movement's fundamental principles, as defined by the Commission, and endorsed by the Conference, notably those of humanitarianism, volunteerism, moralism, transparency, impartiality, empowerment, sustainability, neutrality, benevolence and respect.

## COMMITTEE OF THE BLUE CROSS & BLUE CRESCENT

The Committee of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent (CBC) is a non-governmental humanitarian agency that is part of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement, and works on behalf of vulnerable and oppressed people, worldwide wherever justice, freedom, truth and dignity are denied to men, women and children. The work of CBC strives to limit suffering of victims of war, natural disasters, other humanitarian crisis, and of situations of violence. Our humanitarian workers provide activism, advocacy and lobbying, investigating and raising awareness to expose abuses of those affected by crime, armed violence, terrorism, and conflict, as well as taking action in response to

disaster emergencies. We campaign to educate and mobilise the public and international community, and help transform societies to create a safer, more just world.

The Committee is mandated by the Movement to work to develop and implement movement-wide mission themed programs, and coordinates its programs and campaigns in cooperation with its bilateral partners, the FBC national societies and the Federation and other component agencies that form the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement. The CBC uses its unique position and mandate to operate in situations of humanitarian crisis, natural disasters, violence or conflict, and effectively access vulnerable populations.

The Conference of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Movement (CBCM) otherwise known as the Conference is a non-governmental humanitarian agency that is part of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent movement, and is the supreme deliberative body where all of the movement's component agencies come together as a conference to discuss matters that concern the movement as a whole. The Global Committee of CBCM is the governing body of the Conference and is responsible for overseeing the implementation of and compliance with the resolutions of the Conference. In addition, the Conference coordinates the cooperation between the CBC, the FBC and other bilateral partner agencies of the Movement. The Conference and its national sub-structures are also responsible for organising conferencing, seminars, workshops, meetings, and fund-raising events.

The Conference endorses the Movement's fundamental principles, as defined by the Commission of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent, which are to be shared by all components of the Movement, notably those of humanitarianism, volunteerism, moralism, transparency, impartiality, empowerment, sustainability, neutrality, benevolence and respect.

The official slogan of the Conference of the Blue Cross & Blue Crescent Movement (CBCM) is 'Together for all humanity'

FBCO Cooperative Members are available to quickly respond, and collectively raise the much needed support to provide effective and swift humanitarian assistance to reach vulnerable people in crisis. The scale of modern humanitarian challenges frequently exceeds the coping capacity of individual humanitarian organisations, whereas together, we will be stronger and better able to overcome these humanitarian challenges, united under the emblems of the Blue Cross & Blue Crescent.

The Federation of Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Organisations fundamental objective as mandated by the Movement is to work with its partner member organisations that become part of a FBCO National Cooperative, so that together we can be a strong force in responding, organising, coordinating and leading disaster emergency response missions, as well as supporting, sponsoring and overseeing the direction of an FBC National Society in cooperation with the Federation of Blue Cross & Blue Crescent Societies (FBC).

Under the FBCO umbrella, we also bring together a network of small, grassroots NGO and CSO organisations, and projects, who's activities may otherwise be overlooked and where FBCO members collaborate and endeavour to promote and support each other's organisations to enable them to have the greatest impact on people's lives. The Church is a non-denominational Christian institution, not formally aligned with an established religious denomination, being an ecumenical interdenominational or interreligious confederation that unites a number of affiliating churches, clergy, lay ministers and members that are interested in positive, cooperative and constructive interaction between different Christian communities of different religious traditions to increase understanding and acceptance of each other.

The Church (ChBC) consider that each affiliating church community or congregation is independent and is better off being autonomous without any external directional influence intended on theological doctrine, policy and worship. The ChBC comprises of affiliated church communities of clergy and its lay members, and establishes affiliations with all Christian non-denominational congregations and denominational congregations.

The Church, knows only to well that its efforts for peace between nations is only achievable when there is peace between the different faiths, however we cannot expect peace between the different faiths until there is peace between the different Christian denominations, whilst the objectives of the Church is to bring about interreligious denominational interaction and dialogue, the objectives of its parent body of the Communion is to bring about interfaith interaction and dialogue.

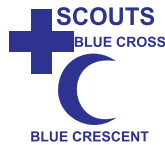
The Communion is a interfaith family of affiliating churches, mosques, synagogues, temples and church communities that are interested in positive, cooperative and constructive interaction between different faith communities of different faith traditions to increase understanding and acceptance of each other.

The Communion is comprised of the Church of the Blue Cross (ChBC), the Mosque of the Blue Crescent (MBC), the Synagogue of the Blue Crystal (SBC), and the Temple of the Blue Crystal (TBC).

The Communion, knows only to well that its efforts for peace between nations is only achievable when there is peace between the different faiths, however we cannot expect peace between the different faiths until there is peace between the different Christian denominations, whilst the objectives of the Communion is to bring about interfaith interaction and dialogue, the objectives of the Church is to bring about interreligious denominational interaction and dialogue.

We provide general information about activities and events relative to Goodwill Ambassadors of our bilateral partner agencies and of our partner organisations, as well as Goodwill Ambassadors of other organisations such as the UN and their agencies, Red Cross Red Crescent and their agencies etc. and through this platform provide an opportunity for the public to see the work performed by Goodwill Ambassadors, whilst popularising the notability of Goodwill Ambassadors.

The Goodwill Ambassadors of the World program is a concept inspired by the United Nations, and since it began the UN Goodwill Ambassador Program has reached to other international organizations like the Red Cross and Red Crescent, and many others. Our program recognises the good works and virtue of our own goodwill ambassadors, such as CBC Goodwill Ambassadors, FBC Goodwill Ambassadors etc.

The work performed by goodwill ambassadors is absolutely essential in raising necessary public awareness to the various causes. Many goodwill ambassadors are often celebrities or people extraordinarily well noted in their career or profession. Goodwill Ambassadors are respectable, professional, well-presented, and decent individuals selected based on their public appeal, celebrity, fame, notability, heritage, popularity, social connections, or ability to network for a particular cause that brings great change to a cause.

**Our Activities:**

At the present time many members are in the process of setting up District Chapters and organising activities and carry out these activities within their own District Chapters. Our current mandate is to provide assistance to those members of our District Chapters that require our support. Our organised activities will help us gain full consultative status with the Federation Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Societies (FBC). FBC National Societies must remain active with a full program of activities for members to remain compliant with FBC criteria to retain FBC National Society membership.

**Our Programs:**

We implement the mission themed programs and campaigns of the Committee of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent. We govern and organise the CBC programs via the CBC Committee of the Indian Blue Cross, a subsidiary body organisation structured into CBC National Assemblies.

**Cooperation Programs:**

We cooperate internationally to implement global programs of other organisations such as the United Nations etc....

**Our Out-reach Activities:**

Outreach activities to other countries are carried out by our Diplomatic Corps members. The Diplomatic Corps or DCBC Delegation is a foreign affairs office and a network of Diaspora Chapters within an FBC Indian Blue Cross Society Delegation. The DCBC Delegation and its Diplomatic Corps objective is to establish relationships with other country delegations and implement out-reach projects outside of the country, assisting those delegations in other countries.

**Our Collaborative Partners:**

We collaborate with many similar International humanitarian and charitable NGOs, CSOs etc., and many of those organisations are institutional members of the Federation of Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Organisations (FBCO)

**Our Collaborations with Bilateral Partners:**

We are the national delegation representing the Blue Cross & Blue Crescent Society on the Conference of the Blue Cross and Blue Crescent Movement (CBCM) and we collaborate with our bilateral partner component agencies that are part of the movement via the Conference.

We are a uniformed organisation but not all of our members are uniformed members. Our members that wear the uniform are part of the CBC-Corps National Command governed by the South Asian and Command.

## Fundamental Principles

### Movement's Twelve Fundamental Principles ~

Our movement is built on our Fundamental Principles that are the basis of all our decisions and actions. Our Principles help safeguard the continuity of our Movement to ensure that we act in a consistent and cohesive manner. We strongly believe our fundamental principles are at the heart of everything we do, our volunteers across the world are guided and governed by these principles and put them into action every day, making a difference to people and planet through sustainable performance.

There are Twelve Fundamental Principles of the Movement; as defined by the Conference, these fundamental principles are Humanitarianism, Volunteerism, Fraternalism, Moralism, Transparency, Impartiality, Self-sufficiency, Empowerment, Sustainability, Neutrality, Benevolence and Respect.

**Humanitarianism** - We will personally and actively engage when possible to the saving of human lives and or to alleviate human suffering during any humanitarian crisis or engage ourselves in promoting human welfare and social reforms.

**volunteerism** - We will voluntarily use our time and talents for charitable, educational, or other worthwhile activities, especially in our own community.

**Fraternalism** - We believe in being a society of men and women associated in brotherly and sisterly union, as for mutual aid or benefit.

**Moralism** - We will practice a particular system of values and follow principles of good conduct, and where ever possible endeavor to distinguish between right and wrong or good and bad behavior and practice what is right and good.

**Transparency** - We will operate in such a way that it is easy for others to see what actions are performed.

**Impartiality** - We will act without discrimination as to nationality, race, religious beliefs, class or political opinions.

**Self-sufficiency** - We believe in the ability to maintain oneself or itself without outside aid, having the capacity to provide for one's own needs, and having an extreme confidence in one's own capabilities or worth.

**Empowerment** - We believe in the power of knowledge and its capacity to mobilize human beings to create a better world.

**Sustainability** - We believe that the needs of the present must never compromise the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.

**Neutrality** - We will endeavour not to take sides when we engage as activists attempting to resolve hostilities, disagreements, or controversies of a political, racial, religious or ideological nature, being guided solely to give priority support for the weaker and vulnerable side.

**Benevolence** - We will endeavour to express kindness, well meaning, and goodwill intent to help those in need, being guided solely by their needs, and to give priority to the most urgent cases of distress, helping those individuals that are in most need.
